In May of 2004, the 911 Cell Phone Bank was created to provide an ongoing and readily available source of emergency cell phones to meet the urgent needs of law enforcement and victim services agencies nationwide.

Since then the 911 Cell Phone Bank has provided thousands of cell phones for victims services organizations. We have successfully relieved the operational burden of managing an emergency cell phone program from our participants.

There is a no cost to participate and the program is easy to implement.

HOW IT WORKS

Collect Cell Phones in Your Community - Get the word out using press releases, letters to the editor, newsletters, your website...any way you communicate with your community. We can provide you with sample press releases and collateral material.

Send Collected Cell Phones to Us - We provide all the shipping materials and pay for shipping. Your program can be tracked using our online tracking tool.

Request Emergency Cell Phones - For each working cell phone you send you "bank" an emergency cell phone. Emergency cell phones are available as you need them.

Request Funds Instead of Phones - If your organization does not need emergency cell phones participating can be a great way to raise money. Simply choose to receive funds instead of phones.
